Requirements:

Professional in counseling or school counseling with associated credentials at the Master's level to provide therapeutic services in Pennsylvania. We are focusing our training cohort on the intervention model for services providers outside of the funded agencies as a step towards promoting sustainability of the IYS model. We will give preference to candidates with these credentials who are working towards sustainability in the IYS Program Series, interested in providing Basic Parenting.

Criteria to participate in CISPA's training for IYS Small Group Therapy (Small Group Dina) and additional information:

Training Dates- September 4-6

Location- Adams County, PA (Gettysburg Area)

Requirements:

Professional in counseling or school counseling with associated credentials at the Master's level to provide therapeutic services in Pennsylvania. We are focusing our training cohort exclusively on a therapeutic / school therapeutic group of professionals. The only exception in these credentials for training with CISPA (by the developer) is for individuals providing the program as a team with a counselor if attending as a team (a paraprofessional level assistant). PCCD funded program participants will have preference for seats at this training. This is an effort to increase the level of sustainability for IYS Program components in Pennsylvania.
